A ratification vote will be conducted from 8:00pm Pacific Daylight Saving Time (pdst) October 13th to 8:00pm (pdst) October 20th using an online ballot sent to your personal email that you provided to the union. If you have not received an email, please contact your regional director with your name and email to get a ballot sent to you. Refer to the CUPE 1767 website (www.cupe1767.ca) for a copy of the MOA that will show the proposed changes to the contract. Additionally, you may have already received an electronic copy of the MOA via email. The voting will be conducted using the voting platform called Election Buddy. This is a secret ballot and will be monitored and conducted by the Returning Officer of the Union (David Robertson) and monitored by the Trustees.

Eligibility:

All members of Canadian Union of Public Employees 1767 are eligible to vote. This includes members on leave. Employees excluded from union membership are not eligible to vote.
